
Dear Residents of Lakeside at Heath,

Recently, our trash service provider has re-evaluated its service in the community, and with the approval from the Board of Directors of Kaufman County MUDs 5, 6 and 7, they have set up a new schedule for trash, recycling, and bulk items collection.

The community will be divided into 4 sections, and each will be serviced 1 day/week on either Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday. Please take the time to review and familiarize yourself with the attached new schedule, which began on July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023. 
## Changes as of July 10 to Trash, Bulk & Recycle Service:

- Dividing the Community into 4 sections. Each section's <u>Trash</u> will be serviced 1 day/week, on either Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday. Cart-contents only in 95-gallon Trash Cart.
- Providing <u>Bulk & Bundled Brush</u> service every other week on Wednesdays. 4 cubic yards each collection day. Half of area serviced in "A Week" and other half of area serviced in "B Week".
- <u>Recycle</u> service in 95-gallon REC Cart for each resident will be the same day as bulk service every other week on Wednesdays.

#### 2023 Holidays

- Fourth of July
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

Service will be delayed by one day the rest of the week after holidays. Friday service will move to Saturday as needed during holiday weeks.

## **Recycling Guidelines**

### **ONLY place these items in the recycling cart:**





**GLASS** 



**PAPER** 



**METAL CANS** 



**PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS** 

TIP: If plastic has a number in the 🚓, recycle it!

### **DOs and DON'Ts of Recycling**

#### DO

- Rinse bottles and cans before placing in your recycle cart.
- Cut down cardboard boxes to fit in the recycle cart.
- Check out RecyclingSimplified.com for great info about recycling.

#### **DON'T**

- ➤ Place plastic bags or any plastic wrapping in recycling.
- ★ Leave the cart lid open more than 6 inches.
- ➤ Place yard or food waste in the recycle cart.
- X Bag recyclables.

# Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Tips

### Sharps

▶ Place needles in a puncture-proof bottle with lid (like a detergent or creamer bottle) and place in regular trash.

#### **Freon®**

▶ Items such as refrigerators, window A/C units and freezers can be collected in bulk trash if the Freon® is removed and tagged. A technician can remove the liquid and tag.

#### **Paints**

Dry paint with sand or kitty litter, then place at the curb with the lid off with regular bulk service.

## Bulk and Bundled Brush

- ► Collected every other week on Wednesdays, according to map and calendar
- ► Collection limit: 4 cubic yards (equal to 4 kitchen stoves)
- ▶ Tree, shrub and brush trimmings must be bundled or securely tied together and not exceed 4 feet in length or 35 lbs. in weight
